COLLEGE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

This internship provides students with experience in all aspects of the Schuylkill Conservation District. Interns will work on District programs, including: watershed restoration and planning, conservation planning, water quality monitoring, farmland preservation, education and outreach, erosion and sediment control, parks and recreation, and office administration.

Interns will collaborate with staff to plan and implement restoration projects, perform maintenance and monitoring of projects, provide overall project support, and raise community awareness on the importance of conservation.

An internship is a great way to network, meet professionals in natural resources conservation, and gain experience in a work environment. The SCD is looking for interns that are not only wanting work experience, but valuable learning opportunities that help develop lifelong skills as well as gaining a deeper understanding of concepts learned in classes through hands-on applications.

Internships are generally offered in the summer (May-August). Other time periods can be requested and arranged on a case-by-case basis. Interns can earn academic credits if arranged through a school advisor.

Qualifications

Basic knowledge of environmental science, data collection and management

Ability to work well in a team and independently with limited supervision

Ability to talk in front of groups including, and not limited to, children, high school students, college students, landowners, and general public

Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions

Ability to use hand and power tools (shovel, mower, brush-cutter, saw, drill, etc)

Available to work occasional weekends and shifts longer than eight hours

Valid driver's license (preferred)

Completion of background checks/clearances and motor vehicle record check/clearances

Working Conditions

Work is performed in a normal office environment with frequent interruptions or in the field. Work requires frequent travel to remote areas of the county (county vehicles available). Work may be performed around hazardous machinery and substances. Some squatting and bending is required, as well as lifting objects up to 25 pounds. When in the field, uneven and rough terrain may be encountered, including during inclement weather where wet and slippery surfaces may be present.
